

Schedule a Medical Appointment—You Do Not Have to Wait for Your Annual Vision Exam

- Your eye doctor accepts both vision insurance and medical insurance, depending on the reason for your visit
- You may be surprised to learn that you can use your medical insurance at your eye doctor's office, as long as you have a medical reason for your visit
- Do not wait for your annual vision exam, because a visit to your eye doctor to get screened for a type of Chronic Dry Eye disease may be covered by your medical insurance
- When you schedule your Chronic Dry Eye disease screening, make sure the office staff lists it as a medical appointment and not as your annual vision exam
